Background About Your Teacher. Your profile should convey to your readers a good sense of who your teacher is as a professional. It should include relevant personal background information as well as information about your teacher's professional training and experience. It should also provide a sense of his or her teaching philosophy and teaching style. Here are some questions to consider as you explore your teacher's life and work:

Try and get a picture of your teacher (It can be one that they provide)

- What grade level and courses are you teaching at NHS?
- What made you decide to become a teacher?
- What noteworthy experiences helped shape the professional your teacher has become? Is there a special moment or event in his or her past that stands out as especially important in influencing him or her?
- What are your teacher's primary goals as a professional? To what extent does he or she feel that he or she has achieved these goals?
- How long have you been teaching and where did you teach previously?
- What did you do as a profession before becoming a teacher?
- What are your teacher's primary goals as a professional? To what extent does he or she feel that he or she has achieved these goals?
- What do you like best about NHS so far?
- Are you involved in any clubs/organizations or coaching positions at NHS?
- What do you do in your free time? Hobbies/interests, outside of education?
